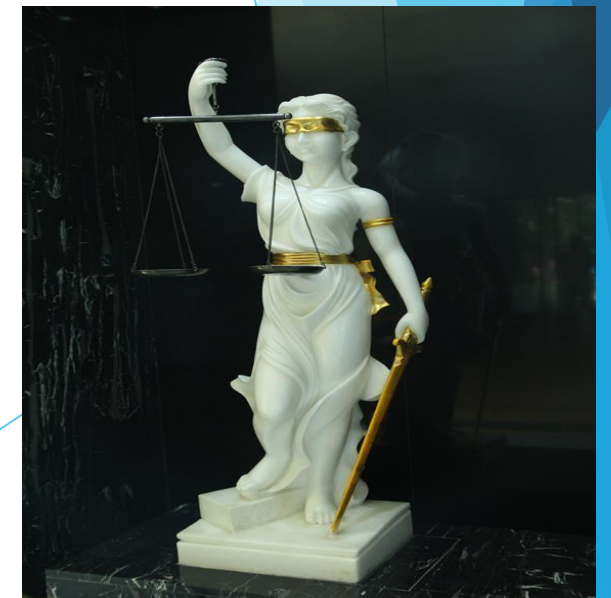
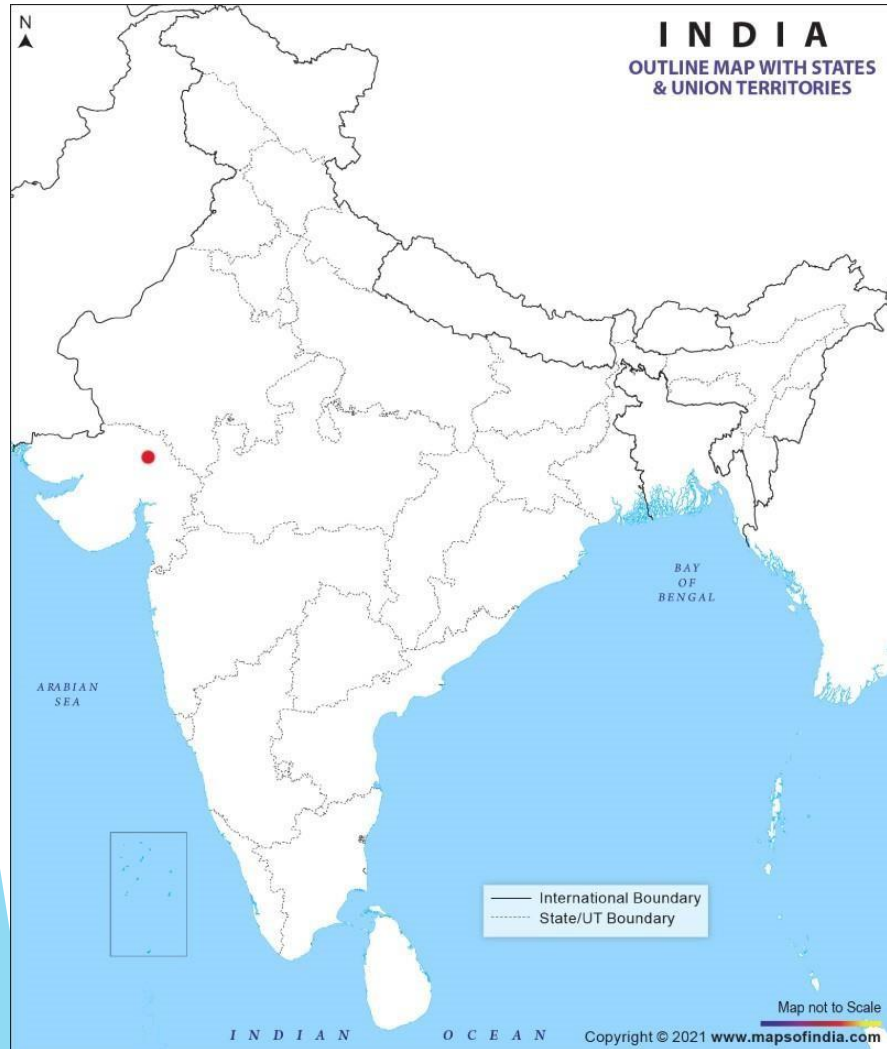

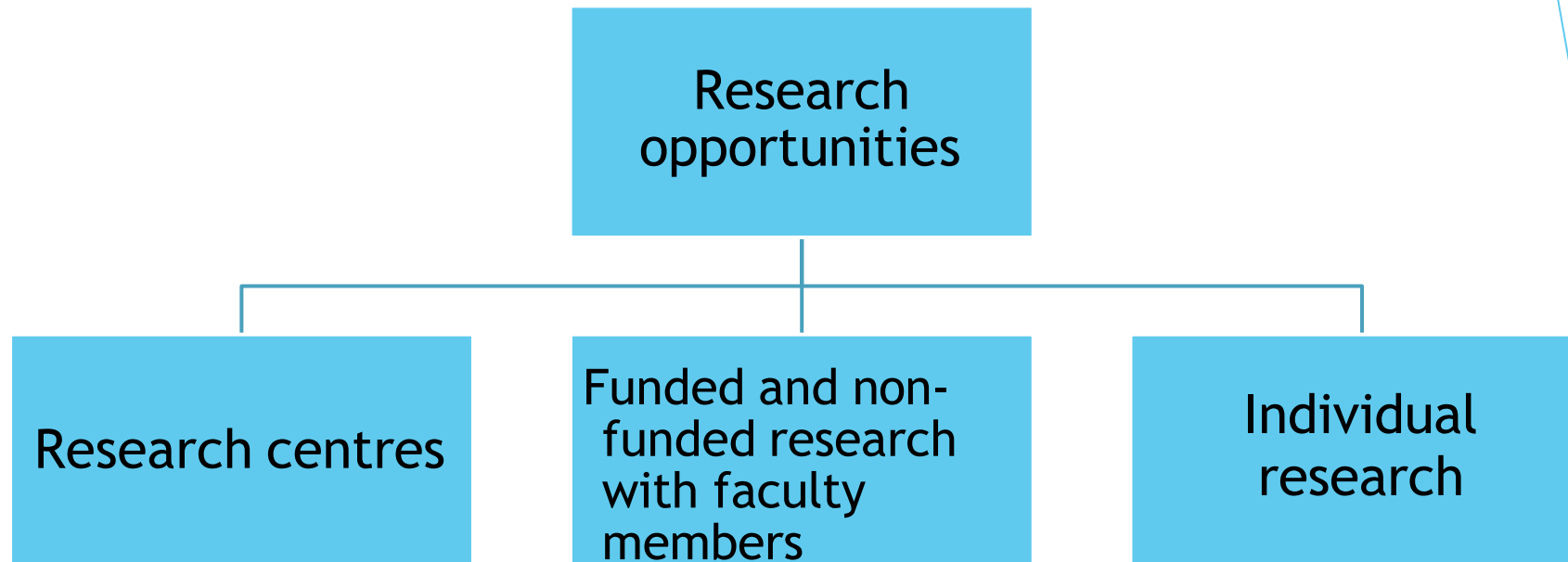

# Teaching and learning methodology

- ▶ Weekly contact hours- 8
- ▶ Teaching through seminar and project work. Research oriented work.
- ▶ Students will be provided with research mentoring.

# Research Projects

The Institute has funded research projects from external agencies as well as the federal and state governments.

Students can also join as research interns only for these projects for a period of three months. This can be subject to extension for a semester.

Students will get the opportunity to undertake doctrinal and empirical research as well as community service.



# Research guidance contd.

- ▶ Inter-disciplinary research within the Institute of Law as well as with other constituent institutes of the University like Management, Architecture, Technology, Design, Pharmacy, Commerce and Science.
- ▶ Students are provided with research mentoring.
- ▶ Student Research Centre- ILNU's research-oriented body which has been established with the aim to stimulate the trend of researching among the students of ILNU.

# Admission Process

- ▶ Entrance examination conducted by ILNU.
- ▶ Date of examination- Last week of January.
- ▶ Tuition fee is INR 1,30,000.
- ▶ Nirma University will provide the students an admission letter which has to be produced in the Indian embassy in the home country.

# Nomination for Exchange Programme

- ▶ The partner university can nominate upto five students for every semester. Deadlines for nomination are as below:

| Semester      | Undergraduate            | Postgraduate             |
|---------------|--------------------------|--------------------------|
| Odd Semester  | 15 <sup>th</sup> March   | 15 <sup>th</sup> January |
| Even Semester | 31 <sup>st</sup> October | 15 <sup>th</sup> March   |

# Documents required by ILNU for Student Exchange Programme

- ▶ Nomination letter from Partner University
- ▶ Transcript of the nominated students
- ▶ CV of the nominated students
- ▶ Passport details of incoming students

# Courses offered during Student Exchange Programme and medium of instruction

- ▶ Combination of Undergraduate and Postgraduate Studies
- ▶ Medium of instruction- English
- ▶ Students are expected to have basic English language proficiency

# Credit Load

| Programme     | Minimum | Maximum |
|---------------|---------|---------|
| Undergraduate | 16      | 18      |
| Postgraduate  | 8       | 16      |

- ▶ 1 local credit is equivalent to 15 hours of classroom engagement and 30 reading hours

# Fee and other expenditure

- ▶ Tuition fee at ILNU is waived
- ▶ Exchange students have to bear living costs during their stay at ILNU

# Housing

- ▶ Accommodation will be available in the guest house of Nirma University. Students will have to bear the rent for the accommodation.
- ▶ Annual guest house charges are approximately INR 1,50,000.
- ▶ Mess charges will have to be borne by the incoming students.

# Insurance

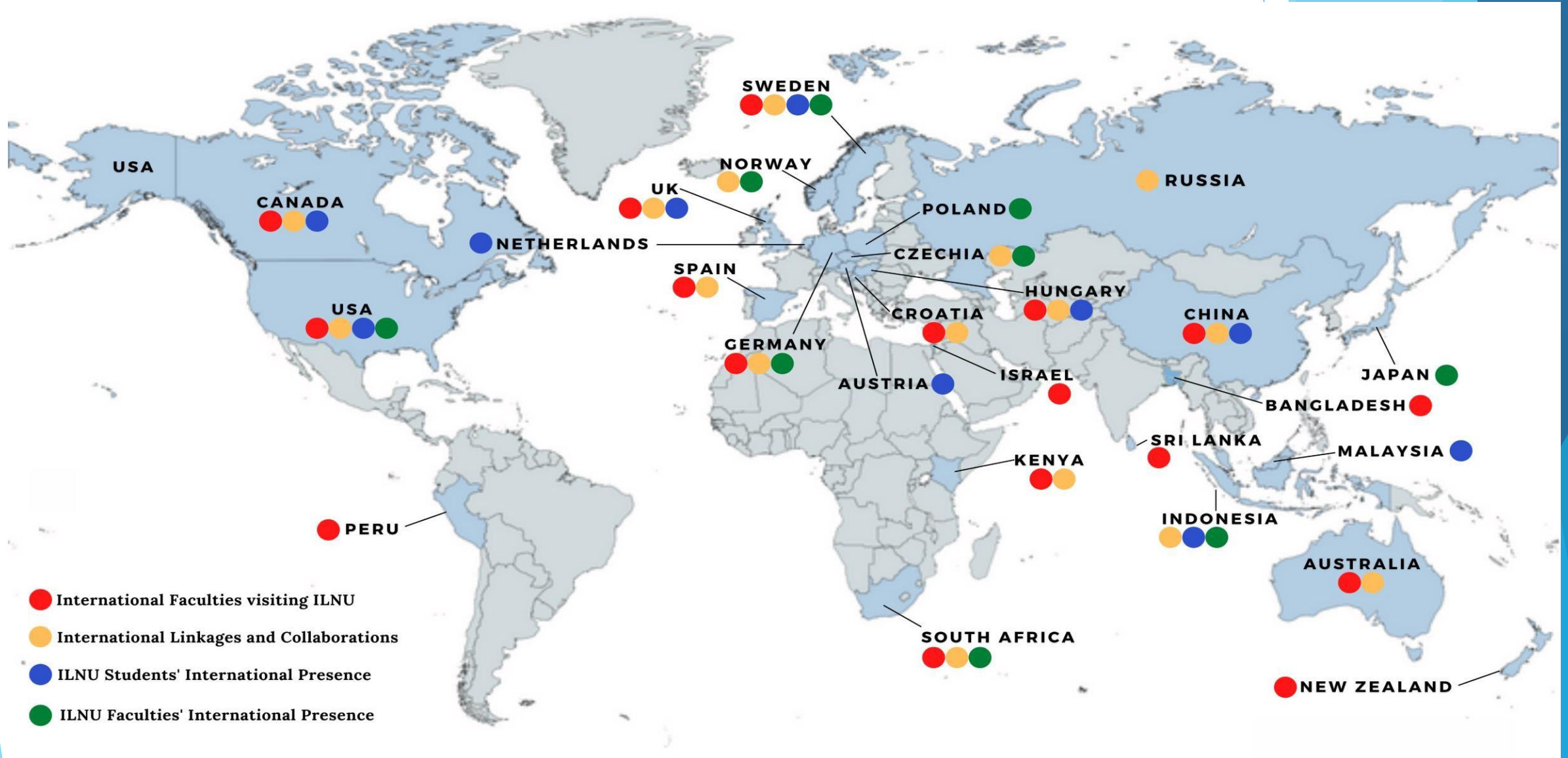
- ▶ Health insurance is not required by Indian immigration law. However, incoming students are advised to buy a health insurance.

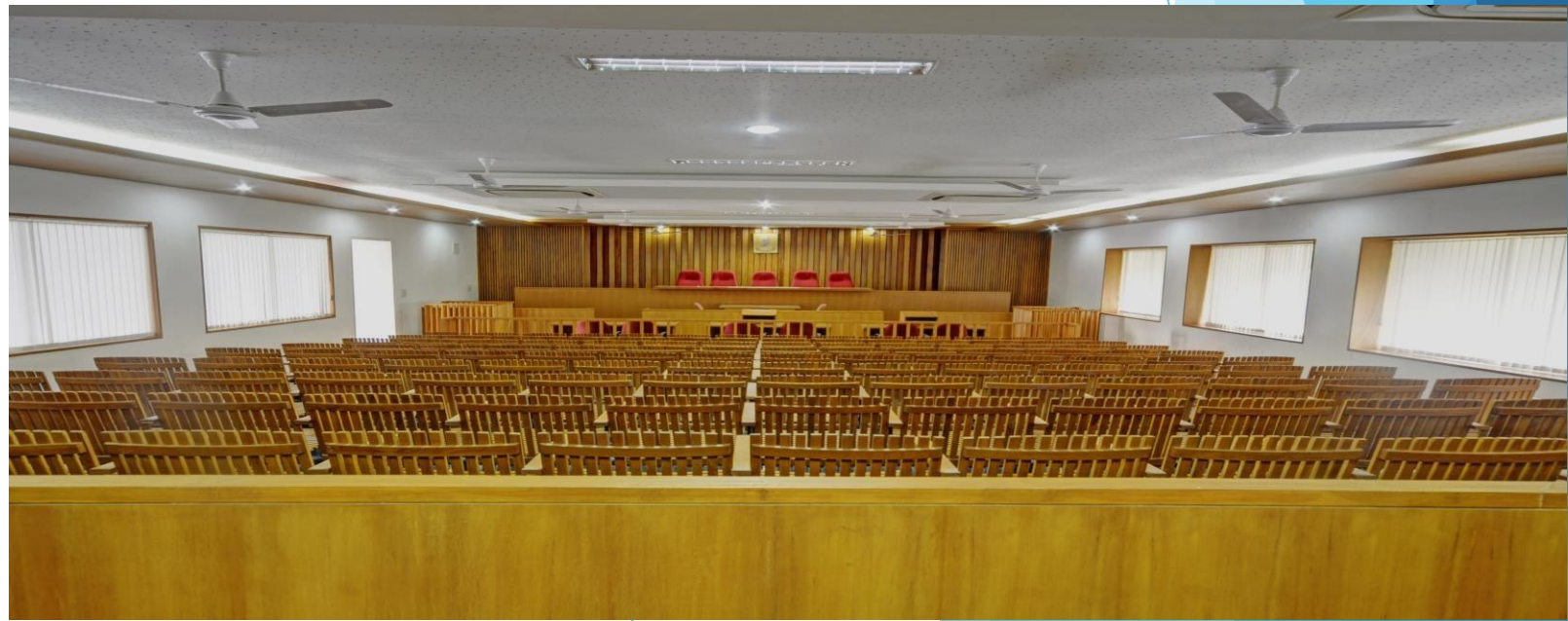
- ▶ Maximum 12 hours in a week
