As part of the Admitted Students' Day, we will conduct a mock class to expose you to the format and complexity of a 1L class session. A packet is provided that contains a case titled *Creel v. Crim* often used in 1L casebooks on Torts. We will use the mock class to extract the law from the case. Prior to the mock class, read the case and then try to answer the accompanying questions. Do not be alarmed if you do not comprehend all of the facts, the terms, or the analytical reasoning contained within the case. A certain level of confusion about the case will exist which is normal. After the case, there are questions that we will use in the mock class to guide the learning. Following the questions, portions of the Torts Second Restatement of the Law are provided which function as a legal encyclopedia with additional points of law related to the main issue in *Creel v. Crim*. We will use the lessons learned from *Creel v. Crim* along with the Restatement excerpts and apply them to the problems on the final page of the packet.
