## PROFESSOR DERMOT GROOME ATTENDS INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL COURT RETREAT IN GLION, SWITZERLAND



Penn State's Dickinson Law Professor Dermot Groome recently returned from a retreat with senior officials of the International Criminal Court (ICC) in Glion, Switzerland. For the past year Professor Groome has been working with six other international criminal justice experts studying issues related to the efficacy and efficiency of the ICC. The retreat, held September 3-5 under Chatham House rules, was the culmination of this work and an opportunity for the experts to discuss their findings and recommendations with the President, Chief Prosecutor, and other senior staff from the ICC. Also in attendance were several representatives of State Parties to the Rome Treaty and senior members of Human Rights Watch and the Open Society Justice Initiative. The retreat was organized and sponsored by the government of Switzerland.

The work of the experts will be formally presented to the entire Assembly of States Parties when they convene in New York this December.
