## **PETER G. GLENN IS NEW PROFESSOR OF EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING AT DICKINSON LAW**

CARLISLE, Pa. — Penn State's Dickinson Law has announced that [Peter G. Glenn](#) has joined the Law School community as Professor of Experiential Learning.

Professor Glenn is currently General Counsel at Stevens & Lee, a position he has held following an eight year tenure as Dean and Donald B. Farage Professor of Law at The Dickinson School of Law of the Pennsylvania State University. Peter also has taught on the law faculties of the University of South Carolina, Case Western Reserve University, Washington and Lee, and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.



During 2003-2005, Peter served the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as Executive Deputy General Counsel. He also spent several months as Acting General Counsel to Governor Edward G. Rendell. Peter served 14 years with a major international law firm as a litigator and was responsible for the development and administration of the firm's lawyer training program.

Peter will teach the Professional Responsibility course this fall. In succeeding semesters, Peter will teach a course in Law Office Management and a course in Transactional Drafting.
